13.	Nandu Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile			£14.00
	Incredibly pure & fast-flowing fruit fills the far-flung corners of the mouth with rich cassis & sweet spices. The tannins are ripe & subtle & the finish rounded.			
14.	Otterbrook Mill Shiraz, Australia	£4.20	£5.50	£16.00
	Complex, elegant and pure. A great example of Australian Shiraz with a lovely, smooth palate showing notes of plum and dark berry fruits, all supported by a touch of toasty oak and a delicate spicy finish.
